
Real Estate signage guidelines





Me Heke Ki Pōneke

Where you <u>can</u> place signage


Signage can be up to 3 square metres in area and up to 4 metres in height

Private land/property, with permission from the property owner

To check the public-private boundary, use our <u>online property map</u>

Private fencing, with permission from the property/asset owner





Closest possible public land location, if the property has zero street visibility

Prior approval from Council is needed in this instance. Email a diagram of your requested location to <u>streetactivities@wcc.govt.nz</u>





Where you <u>can't</u> place signage

This includes the small open-home-style signs


Public fences or other assets
