Wellington City Council has granted your request for information. Please see the below graphs outlining the average building consent processing time and the average code compliance certificate processing time.

The WCC Building Control function following an external audit successfully retained its bi-annual accreditation in May 2021. Retaining accreditation reflects that the building control function is operating well and delivering the required regulatory functions and level of service.

The data series provided demonstrate that over time the WCC building control function is meeting its statutory working day requirements. The recent spike in working days for Certificates of Code Compliance in Q1 2021-22 reflects a process change as a result of the accreditation review in May.
