- (d) Note that public notification of reserve classification is not necessary under section 16 (5)(c) of the Reserves Act 1977, as the terms of agreement with Greater Wellington Regional Council (GWRC) will provide that the classification proposed is a condition subject to which the Land was acquired.
- 3. Note that the transfer of this land from Greater Wellington Regional Council (GWRC)is from one acquiring authority to another pursuant to Section 50 of the Public Works Act 1981.
- 4. Note that the Tawa Community Board has endorsed this report and its recommendations at their meeting of 12 June 2014.
