FUTUREGOV SUMMIT 2011 - PUTRAJAYA, MALAYSIA, OCTOBER 2011

1. Purpose of Report

This report is to seek Council approval for Mayor Wade-Brown to accept an invitation to attend the FutureGov Summit in Putrajaya, Malaysia in October 2011. All expenses associated with the invitation — travel, food and accommodation — are to be met by the event organisers.

2. Recommendations

It is recommended that Council:

- 1. Receive the information.
- 2. Note that the FutureGov Summit 2011 is to be held at Putrajaya, Malaysia from 12-14 October 2011.
- 3. Note that the Mayor has received a VIP invitation to attend, with all expenses associated with the invitation travel, accommodation and food to be met by the Summit organisers.
- 4. Agree that the Mayor accept the invitation to attend the FutureGov Summit 2011.
- 5. Note that a report-back will be presented to an appropriate Committee meeting in accordance with Council Policy.

3. Background

The FutureGov Summit is an annual three-day executive summit, bringing together an invited audience of senior government politicians and officials from across the Asia Pacific region, as well as guest speakers from North America and Europe. This is the seventh annual FutureGov Summit. Hosted by FutureGov magazine, and backed by FutureGov Research, the Summit brings together elected politicians and senior officials from across the Asia Pacific region for intensive knowledge exchange and debate. Over 135 organisations from thirty countries, including Australia, China, the USA and India will be represented. The Summit is to be held at Putrajaya – the administrative capital city of Malaysia.

4. Discussion

Attendance at the FutureGov Summit 2011 is appropriate as the topics to be debated and considered are particularly relevant to Council's current strategic planning, and in particular, relevant to the work being undertaken on *Smart Green Wellington* and the Council's *Economic Development* and *Digital Strategies*. The Summit adopts an interactive format to provide speakers and delegates with the opportunity to debate topical issues in detail. In particular, specific subjects to be covered at this year's summit include:

- Digital Cities
- Citizen Engagement
- Wireless Government
- Open Data Initiatives
- Bridging the Urban-Rural Divide
- Public Sector Performance Management
- Workforce of the Future.
