Comments

The Council has not engaged in genuine consultation with local residents on this issue. In its initial consultation Councillors expressed a pre-determined view in support of the proposal before hearing residents' views. In their consideration of the issue greater weight was given to the views of those who stand to derive commercial benefit from the proposal and non rate payers. This was summarised as the balance of submitters supporting the proposal. We do not support the rezoning to allow continuation of quarrying as this is not an appropriate activity for a residential area. It has significant human health (dust, noise) and amenity (noise, visual) impacts on residents with consequential impacts on property values for which no compensation is proposed. The ongoing presence of a eyesore industrial activity on the northern approaches to the capital city detracts from Wellington's proposition as a progressive and environmentally conscious city. It will impact image and tourism returns accordingly. No other capital city in the world has a quarry in its centre. The continuation of a quarry on the site will negatively impact other existing businesses in the area and prevent the site being redeveloped to provide additional employment/business opportunities. Very few people will be employed under this proposal. There is no need for ongoing guarrying in the middle of a residential area when alternative supplies of aggregate are available less than 10 minutes drive away. The additional cost of importing aggregate from slightly further away has a barely measurable impact on overall construction costs.
