

Decisions on District Plan Changes

The Council has made a decision on the following plan change:

District Plan Change 70 – Earthworks

Plan Change 70 is a change to the objectives, policies and rules that manage earthworks in all areas of the City. Plan Change 70 places all provisions relating to earthworks in two new Chapters of the District Plan (and deletes existing earthworks provisions from the Operative Plan). The new provisions address the following issues:

- Stability
- Erosion, dust and sediment control
- Flood Hazard Areas
- Character and amenity of streams and wetlands
- Visually sensitive areas
- Transport of material
- Cultural and archaeological sites.
