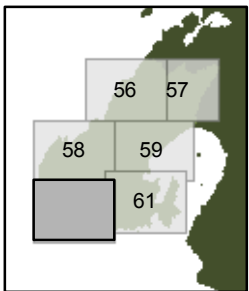

Outlook Hill - Quartz Hill Ridge

- Rural landscape context
- Landmarks: Outlook Hill a distinctive skyline feature from the coast and inland
- Rugged coastal natural character towards the south and north ends of the ridge
- Pattern of pasture-covered summit land and regenerating vegetation on steep flanks

Wrights Hill

- Landmark flat-topped hill
- Prominent skyline feature and green backdrop seen from central city and western suburbs
- Native forest and regenerating vegetation developing on flanks and parts of summit

Karori Stream

Te Kopahau Ridge

- Rugged skyline and hill backdrop seen from central city and eastern suburbs
- Landmark: Hawkins Hill, Te Kopahau, Tip Track spur
- Vegetation regenerating on steep flanks and parts of the summit land

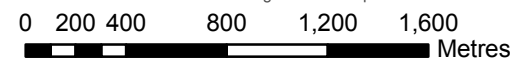
