Would you like to gain practical New Zealand work experience?

Wellington City Council and the Ministry of Social Development, Work and Income, Wellington have a 12-month work experience programme to help migrants and refugees. We have a range of work experience opportunities available around the Council in areas such as libraries, roading, administration, swimming pools, parks and gardens and many more.



Who: Migrants and refugees who:

- have been in New Zealand no longer than five years
- have English as a second language
- live in Wellington and are looking for work.

What: Full-time paid work experience placements for one year at Wellington City Council.

There are 12 positions on the programme and as people move on vacancies will be filled.

When: Friday 9 May.

How: Send us your CV along with the application form. Applications will be considered and those who are best suited will be invited to attend a meeting to discuss the programme further.

Payment: If you are selected to be in the programme you will receive around \$500 a week (less tax).
