Officers recommend that the Committee:

## Background:

The ePetition "Oppose proposed road stopping Jaunpur Crescent, Broadmeadows" was initiated by Mr Ron Zoest on 3 February 2012 and closed on 3 April 2012.

The purpose of the petition is to request that Council not sell the land for residential development.

The petition was open to all members of the public with internet access to the Council's website. The petition received 56 signatures, 17 from Wellington 39 from people Thailand, Singapore and Malaysia.

## Officers' response:

The land is surplus to Council's requirements and no longer needed for any public work. The public will be invited to make submissions on this proposal through the public notification process around May or June 2012. Objections received after this date will be reported back to the Regulatory Processes Committee for consideration. Objectors will also have the opportunity to make oral submissions if they so wish. Mr Zoest's e-petition should be considered at the same time.
