 - 47. If the Chairperson is absent or withdraws from the meeting then the Deputy Chairperson shall preside at that meeting of the Board.
 - 47. (a) For that meeting only, the Deputy Chairperson or Board Member elected to preside shall be entitled to exercise all the powers normally exercised by the Chairperson.
 - 48. If both the Chairperson and the Deputy Chairperson are absent from any meeting of the Board then the Board Members present shall elect one of their number to preside at that meeting of the

Board. If more than one Board Member seeks election, the matter shall be decided using the voting system described in Standing Order 170.

3. Agree to delete Standing Orders 195 and 199 and that they are replaced as follows:

Public Participation

- 195. A period of at least 10 minutes shall be set aside near the beginning of Board meetings [cf Item 3 in S.O.72] to enable members of the public to make statements about any matter that may be of importance to the residents of Tawa.
- 199. A member of the public wishing to raise a substantive matter should be invited to present it under the provisions of **S.O. 200 204 [Deputations]**.
- 4. Note that Wellington City Council will be reviewing its Standing Orders in 2012 and that the Board may wish to revisit its standing orders in light of the changes made.
