Proposal: Bus Priority Lanes

**Information:** The Bus Priority Plan was approved by SPC in April 2007. Bus priority measures

are aimed at making travel by bus more attractive and reliable, encouraging a shift from private cars to buses, facilitating a more efficient and environmentally friendly means of transport, future-proofing bus movements from the effects of growing traffic congestion, helping buses bypass congestion and reducing journey

times.

It is proposed that the next stage of the Bus Priority Plan include Courtenay Place, Kent and Cambridge terraces and Adelaide Road all of which carry large bus flows and significant levels of general traffic.

Courtenay Place is the last section of the Golden Mile to be considered for bus priority. Bus lanes on Courtenay Place will provide benefits for bus travel times and reliability. The traffic lanes are currently wide enough to provide for a bus lane with little effect on parking, without restricting general traffic or effecting footpath widths for the majority of the street in both directions.

Kent and Cambridge terraces currently have peak time clearways for most of their length. The proposal is to convert the clearways to bus lanes for the full length from Courtenay Place to the Basin Reserve. In Cambridge Terrace the bus lane is proposed to operate in the morning peak from 7am to 9am. Similarly in Kent Terrace the bus lane is to operate in the evening peak from 4pm to 6pm. In Kent Terrace the clearway already operates between Elizabeth Street and the Basin Reserve. Parking surveys on Kent and Cambridge terraces show that there were generally low parking occupancy rates, so it is considered any effected parking can be accommodated by parking against the central median.

Improvements for bus travel times are expected to be achieved south bound on Adelaide Road by converting the existing 4pm-6pm clearway to a bus lane from just south of the Basin Reserve to John Street.






