

## Summary of Submissions

**Proposed District Plan Change 74**  
**Telecommunication Structures**  
**Wellington City District Plan**  
**Clause 7 of First Schedule, Resource Management Act 1991**

Wellington City Council has prepared a summary of submissions on proposed District Plan Change 74. Plan Change 74 proposes to amend the rules in the District Plan which manage telecommunication structures (eg. masts, antennas and cabinets). This includes rules on where structures can and cannot go, and how tall they can be. Twelve submissions were received. Some submissions support the plan change, some sought changes to particular provisions and a number of submissions were from amateur radio operators concerned about the effect of these provisions on their activities.

The further submission must be on Form 6 of the Resource Management (Forms, Fees and Procedure) Regulations 2003, or similar, and must state whether or not you wish to present your views at a Council hearing. **Submissions close at 5pm on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> December 2009.**

The process for public participation from this point is as follows:

- if a person making a submission or further submission asks to be heard in support of his or her submission, a hearing must be held
- the Council will give its decision on the proposed Plan Change (including its reasons for accepting or rejecting submissions)
- anyone who has made a submission or a further submission has the right to appeal the decision to the Environment Court.

Within five working days of making your further submission to Council, you must provide a copy of your submission to any original submitter(s) that you have opposed or supported.
