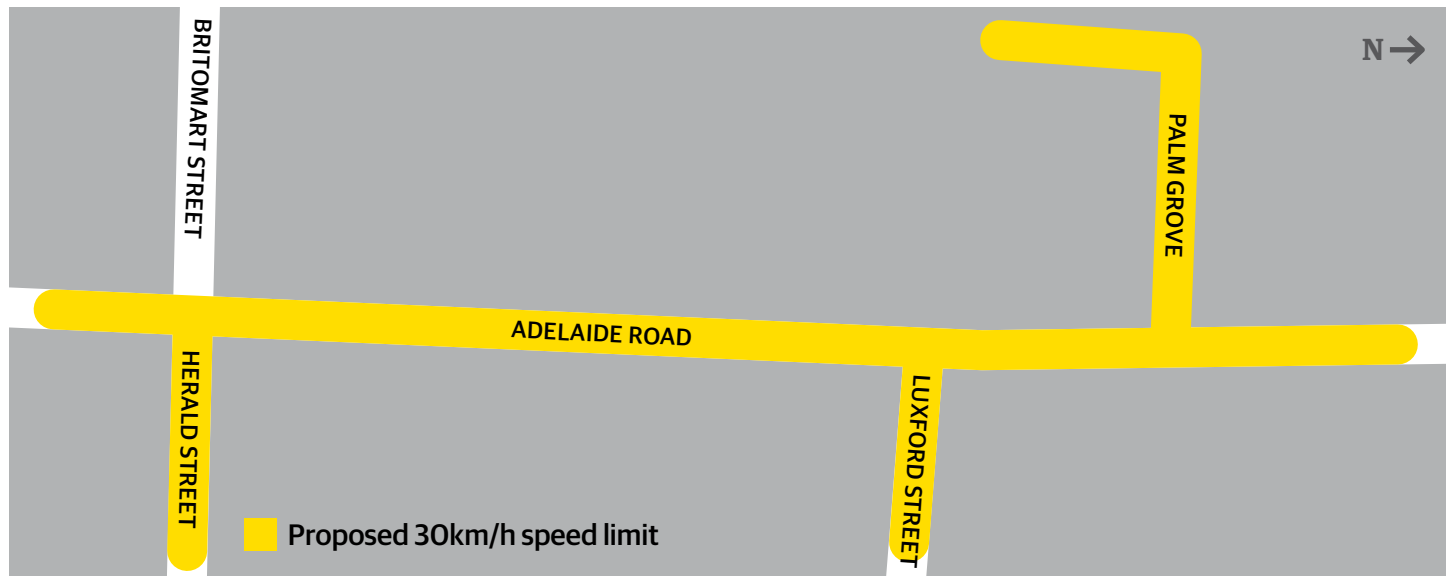




Safer speed limit proposed for Berhampore shopping area

The Council is proposing a safer speed limit in the Berhampore shopping area of 30km/h



Tell us what you think

The Council proposes to reduce the speed limit in the Berhampore shopping area and surrounding streets from 50km/h to 30km/h.

This proposal to reduce vehicle speeds will make Berhampore's streets safer and more pleasant for all road users.

There will be little effect on motorists' travel times, as the average speed in this area is already close to 30km/h.

From 2007-2014, a total of 28 injury crashes were reported in the area,

9 of which resulted in injuries to pedestrians. Studies show that reducing vehicle speeds significantly reduces the number and severity of injuries.

The Council has reduced the speed limit in 10 other shopping centres including Hataitai, Miramar, Seatoun, Strathmore Park and Kilbirnie.

Adelaide Road	From 35 metres north of its intersection with Palm Grove to 75 metres south of its intersection with Herald Street.	30 km/h	255 metres
Palm Grove	All of the road	30km/hr	All of the road
Luxford Street	From its intersection with Adelaide Road to 105 metres east of Adelaide Road	30 km/h	100 metres
Herald Street	From its intersection with Adelaide Road to the foot of the steps by 60 and 67 Herald Street	30km/hr	100 metres
