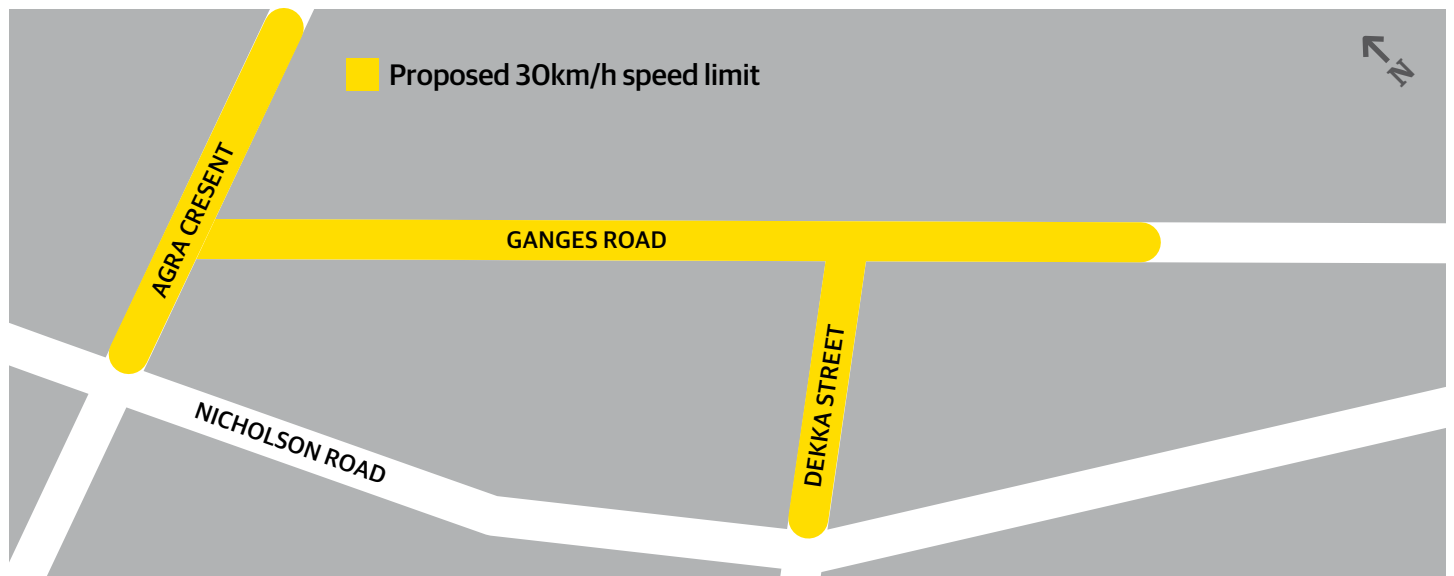




Safer speed limit proposed for Khandallah shopping area

The Council is proposing a safer speed limit in the Khandallah shopping area of 30km/h



Tell us what you think

The Council proposes to reduce the speed limit in the Khandallah shopping area and surrounding streets from 50km/h to 30km/h. This would apply to all vehicles at all times.

This proposal to reduce vehicle speeds will make Khandallah's streets safer and more pleasant for all road users.

There will be little effect on motorists' travel times, as the average speed in this area is already close to 30km/h.

From 2007-2014, a total of 7 injury crashes were reported in the area,

4 of which resulted in injuries to pedestrians. Studies show that reducing vehicle speeds significantly reduces the number and severity of injuries.

The Council has reduced the speed limit in 10 other shopping centres including Hataitai, Miramar, Seatoun, Strathmore Park and Kilbirnie.

Street	Legal description	Speed limit	Distance
Ganges Road	From its intersection with Agra Crescent to a point 95 metres south of Dekka Street	30 km/h	200 metres
Dekka Street	From its intersection with Ganges Road to its intersection with Nicholson Road	30 km/h	135 metres
Agra Crescent	From its intersection with Nicholson Road to a point 60 metres east of Ganges Road	30 km/h	115 metres
