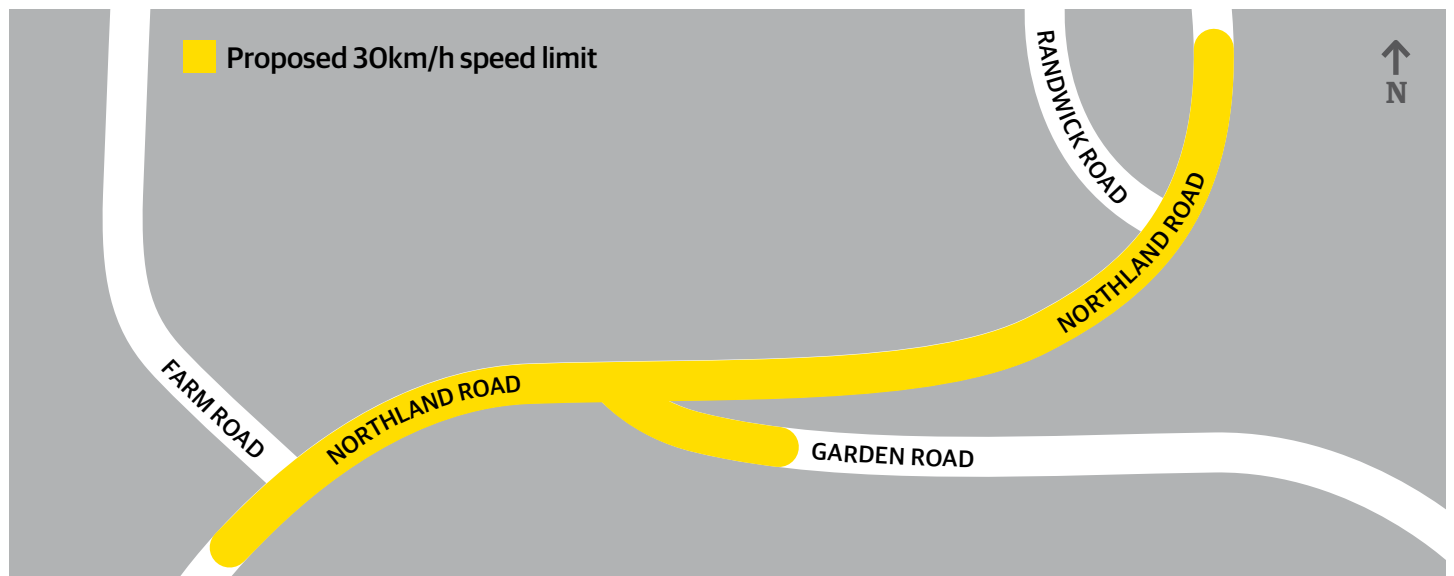




# Safer speed limit proposed for Northland shopping area

The Council is proposing a safer speed limit in the Northland shopping area of 30km/h



## Tell us what you think

The Council proposes to reduce the speed limit in the Northland shopping area and surrounding streets from 50km/h to 30km/h. This would apply to all vehicles at all times.

This proposal to reduce vehicle speeds will make Northland's streets safer and more pleasant for all road users.

There will be little effect on motorists' travel times, as the average speed in this area is already close to 30km/h.

From 2007-2014, a total of 10 injury crashes were reported in the area,

1 of which resulted in injuries to pedestrians. Studies show that reducing vehicle speeds significantly reduces the number and severity of injuries.

The Council has reduced the speed limit in 10 other shopping centres including Hataitai, Miramar, Seatoun, Strathmore Park and Kilbirnie.

Street	Legal description	Speed limit	Distance
Northland Road	From 25 metres South of Farm Road to 115 metres north of it's intersection with Randwick Road	30 km/h	275 metres
Garden Road	From its intersection with Northland Road to a point 25 metres east of Northland Road	30 km/h	25 metres
