Information: Council officers recently consulted on TR53-16 in May 2016 which proposed installing No Stopping Restrictions on Pinnacle Street and Mantell Street.

Following the feedback received, WCC have made amendments to the proposed traffic resolution. To address the concerns raised, Council officers are now proposing to install 8 metres of No Stopping Restrictions outside 27A Pinnacle Street to assist vehicles left turning into Pinnacle Street in a safer manner and within the centre-line.
