**Proposal:** Coach Stop 8-9:00am, 5-6:30pm Mon-Sun  
P10 Time Limited Other Times

**Information:** Council Officers have received a request from Park Hotel to address coach parking and short-term parking shortage within close proximity to the hotel premises on 101-103 The Terrace.

Outside the Park Hotel are two metered parking spaces, with a 120 minute time restriction. It has been determined that the current restrictions do not fully cater to current demands.

The purpose of this resolution is to convert two existing metered parking spaces into a designated area for coaches.

Net metered parking loss: 2 spaces  
Coach Stop gain: 2 spaces

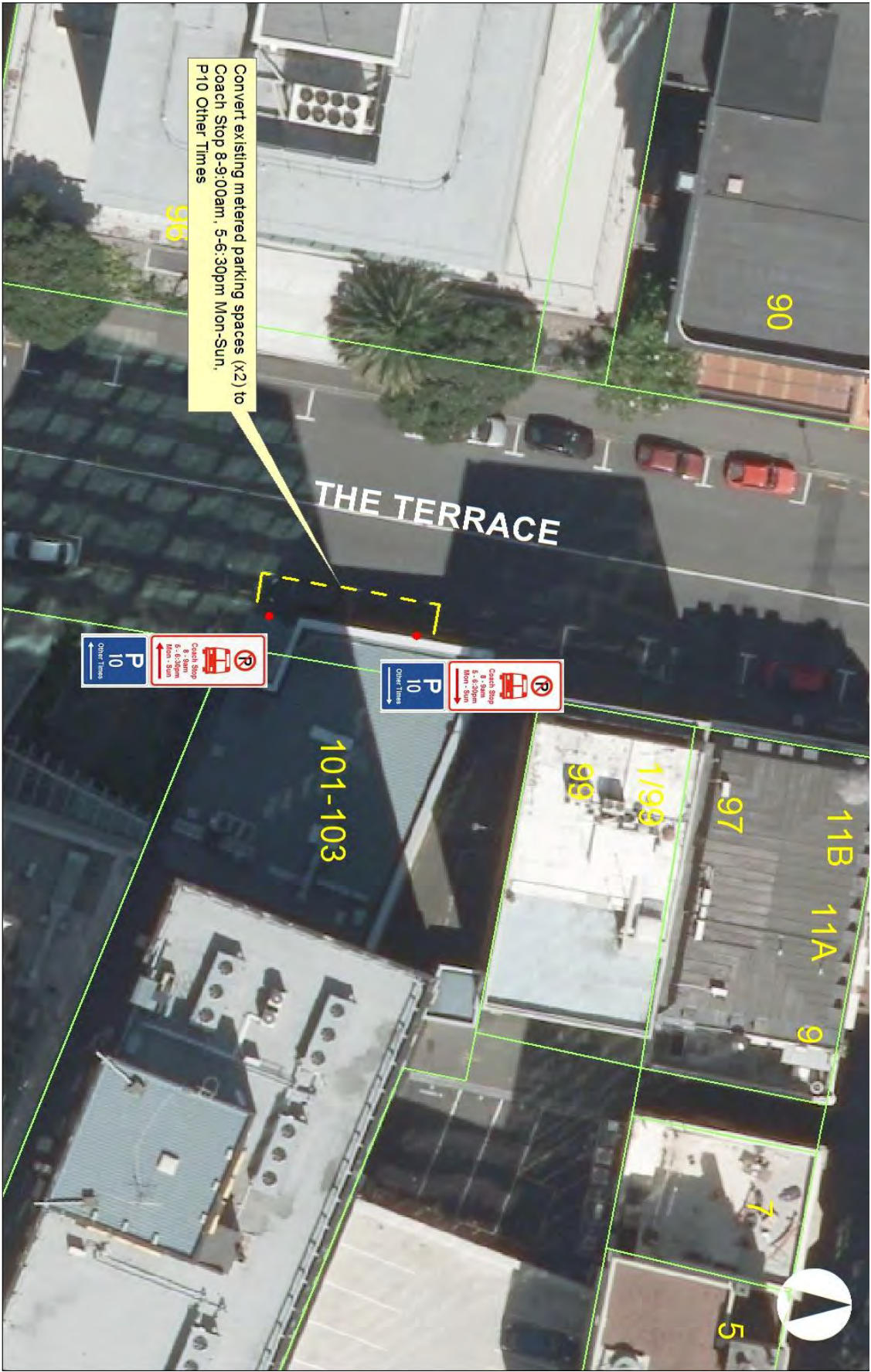

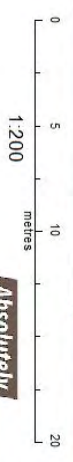
