Location: Broadmeadows Bus Stops - Broadmeadows

Proposal: New Bus Stop for Kanpur Road.

Information: The proposal in this report covers the establishment of a new bus stop on Kanpur Road, Broadmeadows in the Onslow – Western Ward.

As part of the new bus network commencing in mid-2018 it is proposed that a new bus route 24 will provide an all-day service in Broadmeadows replacing the current peak-only route 46 and weekday hourly daytime shopper service route 50. Buses would also run on weekends providing a 7 day a week service to Broadmeadows, there is currently only a weekday only service.

Bus route 24 will also provide direct connections to and from Johnsonville and Khandallah, making more destinations easily accessible by bus from Broadmeadows.

Under the existing bus services, both routes (46 and 50) only run at limited times and operate a clockwise loop through Broadmeadows serving John Sims Drive, Kanpur Road, Nalanda Crescent and Rajkot Terrace.

In the revised bus service network proposals, Broadmeadows would receive a more frequent service throughout the week and operate in both directions on these roads through Broadmeadows.

As a result of this new anti-clockwise loop seven (7) new bus stops are required on John Sims Drive, Kanpur Road, Nalanda Crescent and Rajkot Terrace. Six of the new bus stops were approved in 2016 in preparation of the new service. These were:

1. Outside 23 John Sims Drive
2. Outside 47 John Sims Drive
3. Outside 17 Nalanda Crescent
4. Outside 42 – 44 Kanpur Road
5. Opposite 1 Kanpur Road
6. Outside 4 Rajkot Terrace

These stops are located in the vicinity of the existing stops on these roads.

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One stop is yet to be approved on Kanpur Road in the vicinity of Jaunpur Crescent.

An earlier proposal to locate a stop outside 76-78 Kanpur Road has been further investigated following earlier engagement. Consideration of this stop in relation to its proximity to the the intersection of Jaunpur crescent has resulted in the current proposal to establish a stop outside 72 Kanpur Road.

While general parking will be lost at this site, this has been minimised, as far as practical, by using an area across existing driveways. It should also be noted that there is sufficient parking in the general area to serve local needs and the effect on over all parking is minimal recognising most properties in the area have off street parking.

The establishment of this stop will complete the adequate servicing of this route for all bus users.
