Information: Wellington City Council has received concerns regarding parking on Nicholson Road outside St. Benedict's School (#50 Nicholson Road) during the morning and afternoon pick up / drop off hours. The principal of St. Benedict's School advised the council that during peak hours both Nicholson Road and Everest Street become congested due to limited parking available for the parents to park near the school. Upon a site inspection and assessment of the situation during an afternoon peak hour, the concerns raised were confirmed. Both the zebra crossing and Kea crossing installed are functioning, but the safer use of these school controlled crossings needs to be addressed. The kea crossing on Everest street can become blocked due to congestion especially at the pick-up times. Cars waiting to access the pick - up and drop off parking on Nicholson Road sometimes stop over the broken yellow lines (on the approach to the school controlled zebra crossing). Cars were also seen to block driveway(s) on Everest Street while waiting in line for a pick up space on Nicholson Road. This also results in limited manoeuvring for vehicles around queuing traffic.

The proposal to address the safety and congestion concerns at school peak hours is to convert 1 unrestricted parking space to 1 extra pick up / drop off parking space during school peak hours only. The total number of pick up / drop off spaces will increase from 2 to 3. This will assist in reducing the queues for pick up / drop off and make the operation of both the zebra and kea crossings safer. To facilitate safe pedestrian access to the proposed space, the footpath will be extended approximately 10 metres.

The purpose of this resolution is to convert 1 unrestricted parking space to be used as pickup / drop off during school peak times.
