- Location:** Ferguson Street, Newtown
- Proposal:** No Stopping At All Times Parking Restriction
- Information:** Council officers have received concerns over vehicles parking on the western side of Ferguson Street.

The road is narrow outside numbers 17 and 19 Ferguson Street, meaning if cars park opposite the driveways, it is difficult for cars to get out.

Site investigation has been undertaken to understand the concerns. It has been found that residents currently park their vehicles directly opposite the driveways of 17 and 19 Ferguson Street, on the west side of the road, restricting access to these properties. With the current parking arrangement, the 'aisle' distance width is less than the required 5.8m specified by AS/NZS 2890.1:2004 Parking Facilities Part 1: Off-Street Car Parking.

Council officers propose to install No Stopping At All Times parking restriction on the west side of Ferguson Street, across from 17 and 19 Ferguson Street.

Net parking loss: 4.

The proposed no stopping restrictions are shown on the attached plan.
