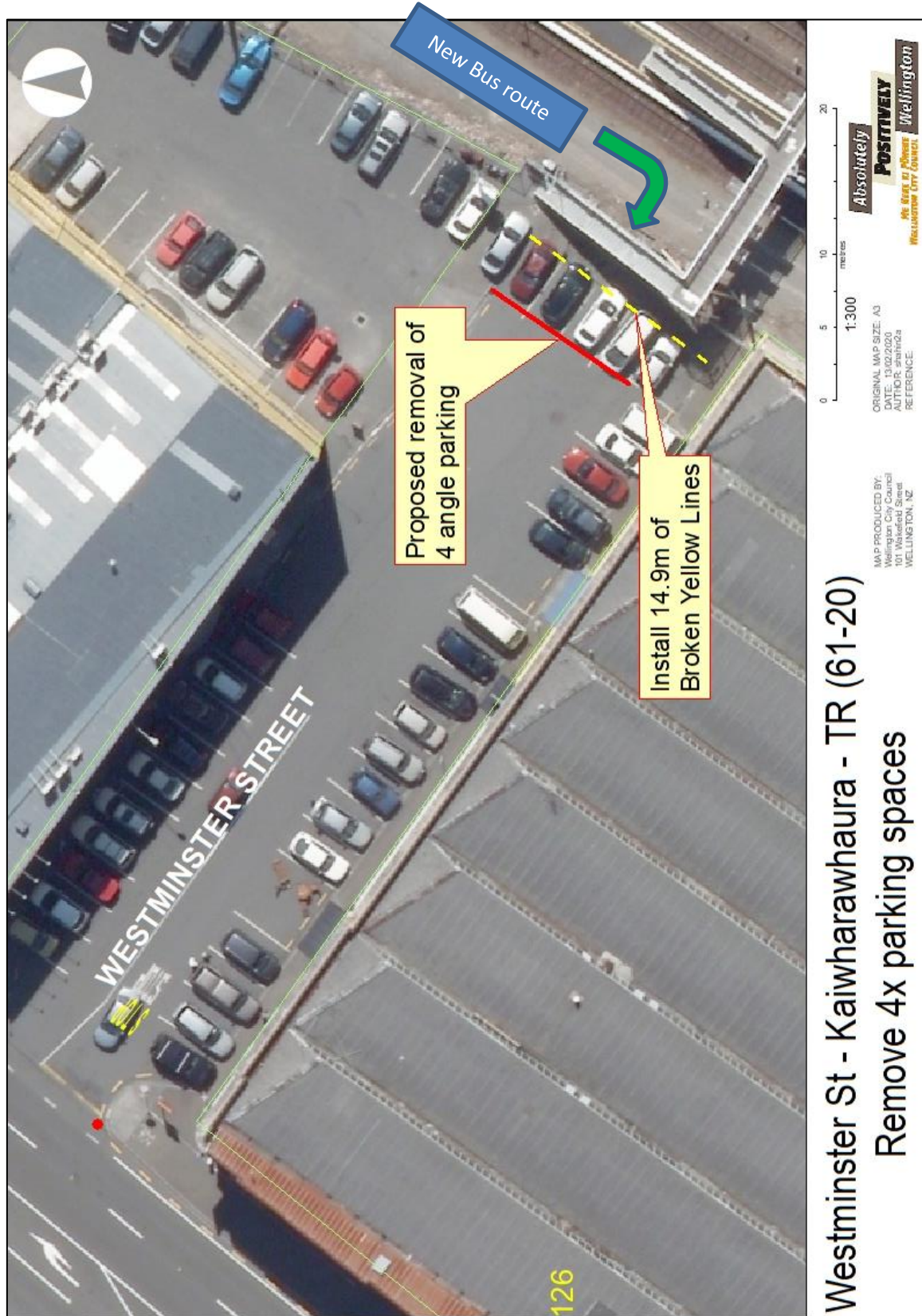
You are receiving this leaflet as **we would like to inform you of a proposed change** we are making in or around your neighbourhood/place of business.

## Proposal:

<b>What we'd like to do</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Install 14.9 metres of broken yellow lines</li></ul>
<b>Why we are proposing the change</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The request was raised by Greater Wellington Regional Council who require the parking spaces removed to allow safe access for a bus service to the Kaiwharawhaura train station</li><li>• To enable operation of Kaiwharawhaura Train Station, Greater Wellington Regional Council and KiwiRail require a bus route to the station and bus access to the train station</li></ul>
<b>Location – where we propose to make the change</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• End of Westminster Street, Kaiwharawhaura</li></ul>
<b>Impact</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The resolution will resolve accessibility issues faced by buses.</li><li>• Loss of 4 parking spaces.</li></ul>
