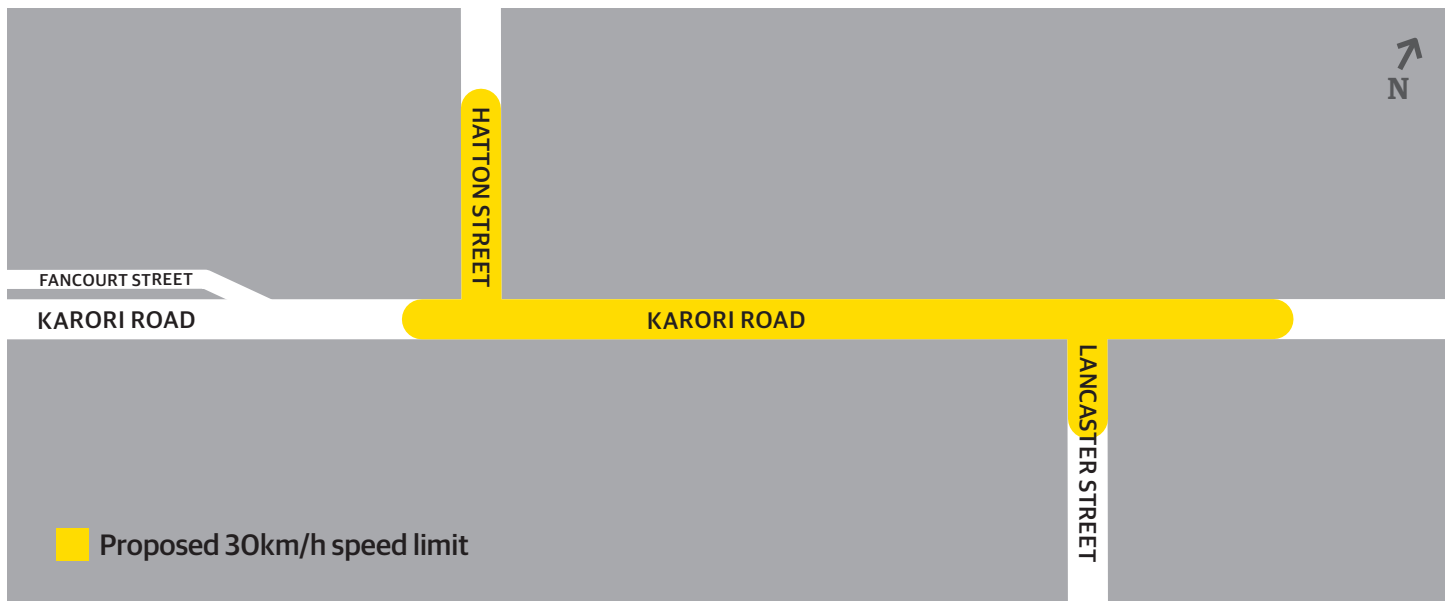




Safer speed limit proposed for Marsden Village shopping area

The Council is proposing a safer speed limit in the Marsden Village shopping area.



Have your say

Wellington City Council would like your feedback on its plan to reduce the speed limit in the Marsden Village shopping area from 50km to 30km.

To have your say, go to wellington.govt.nz/karorispeedlimits and fill out the submission form online. Please provide your feedback by 5pm on Monday 22 June 2020.

This proposal to reduce vehicle speeds will make Karori's streets safer and more pleasant for all road users.

There will be little effect on motorists' travel times, as the average speed in this area is already close to 30km/h.

Studies show that reducing vehicle speeds significantly reduces the number and severity of injuries.

The Council has reduced the speed limit in 15 other shopping centres including Northland, Ngaio, Khandallah and Wadestown.

Street	Legal description	Speed limit	Distance
Hatton Street	From its intersection with Karori Road to a point 21 metres north of Karori Road	30 km/h	21 metres
Lancaster Street	From its intersection with Karori Road to a point 15 metres south of Karori Road	30 km/h	15 metres
Karori Road	From a point 67 metres south-west of Homewood Avenue to a point 8 metres south-west of Hatton Street	30 km/h	215 metres
