This leaflet is to let you know about a change we are proposing to make in your neighbourhood.

Proposal:

What we'd like to do	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Install 39 metres of broken yellow along the northern side of Harrold Street.
Why we are proposing the change	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Council officers have received a request from a local resident concerned about vehicles parking on both sides of Harrold Street restricting access for road users. Currently the width of the road when vehicles are parked on both sides is 0.75 metres.
Location – where we propose to make the change	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Harrold Street, Highbury - between no.5A to no.9
Impact	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Improves safety and accessibility for vehicles on Harrold Street.• Removal of 7 parking spaces.
