This leaflet is to let you know about a change we are proposing to make in your neighbourhood.

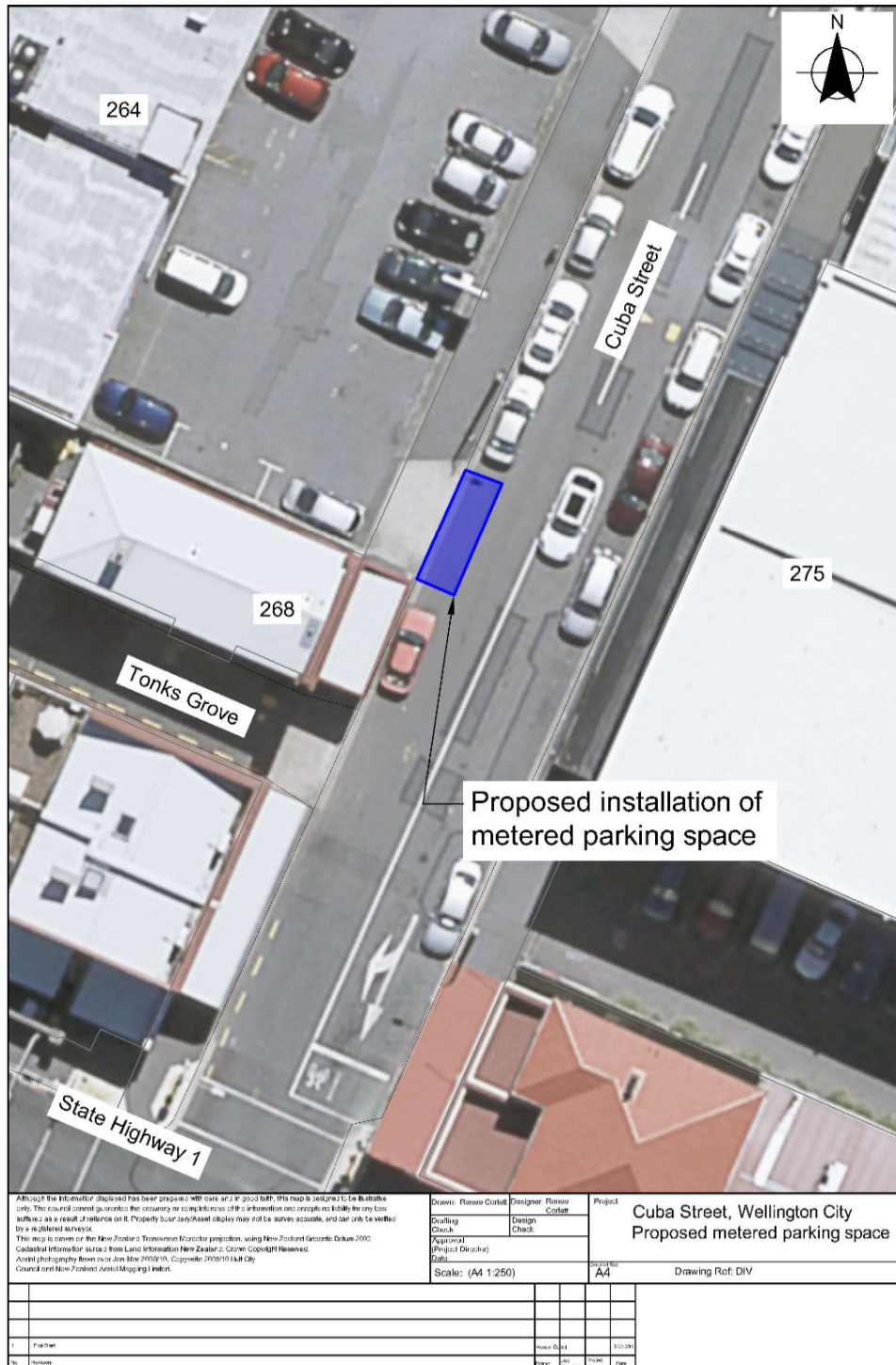

| <b>Reference</b>                                      | TR88-21 Cuba Street, Te Aro - metered parking   |
| <b>What we'd like to do</b>                           | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Install one metered parking space along the west side of Cuba Street outside no.264.</li></ul>  |
| <b>Why we are proposing the change</b>                | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• We have received confirmation from Hey Day that the southern vehicle crossing is no longer used or required and is safely blocked off with the installation of bollards.</li><li>• We propose a metered parking space to be installed in this location which is consistent with the surrounding on-street parking restrictions.</li></ul>   |
| <b>Location – where we propose to make the change</b> | Cuba Street, Te Aro – outside no.264  |
| <b>Impact</b>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Improves accessibility with greater availability of parking.</li><li>• Net parking impact - addition of one metered parking space.</li><li>• Pedestrian impact - no change.</li></ul>   |
| <b>How this relates to the parking policy</b>         | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• This proposal reflects the existing metered parking along this street.</li><li>• Support business wellbeing – ensure parking management and pricing controls support economic activity in the central city, suburban centres, and mobile trades and services.</li></ul>   |
