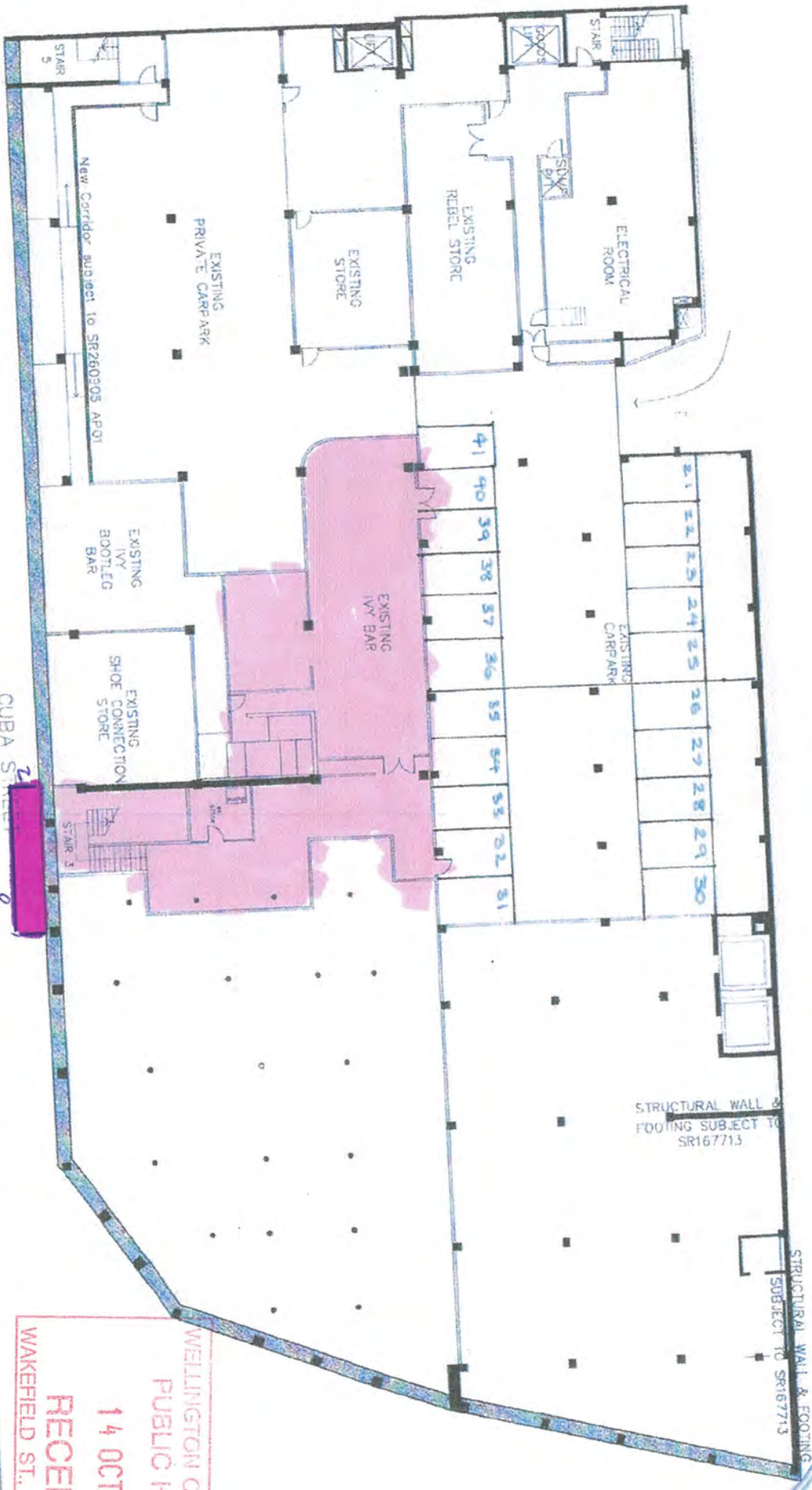

Permission is granted to use the footpath area as follows:

- Area and location: The area marked in yellow on the photograph and map shown below of the footpath outside the premises at **63 CUBA STREET, Te Aro**.
- Maximum number of tables and chairs: **4 Table leaners**
- Permitted hours of use: **Monday to Saturday 7:00pm to 4:00am the following day**
- Expiry date of permission: **30 June 2022**

Alcohol may only be served and consumed in this area in accordance with the conditions of a licence issued under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. This document is not a licence issued under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

Conditions:

1. For outdoor seating, the Pavement Permission and approved site plan must be displayed in the licensed area, or in the business's window, so that it is visible at all times and able to be easily read by persons outside.
2. Tables and chairs are to be high quality, durable, waterproof and weather resistant, designed for outdoor use, be well maintained and must comply with NZS4121.
3. Tables are only permitted to be located within the area marked on the map attached to your permission. Up to a maximum of **4 Table leaners** may be placed within the designated area. All other footpath areas are to be kept clear at all times.
 - a. Adequate space is to be provided within the area to allow for easy movement and chair use.
 - b. The outdoor seating area must allow for unobstructed access to and from the premises.
 - c. The outdoor seating area will not interfere with safe and efficient pedestrian movement and the minimum unobstructed footpath width as outlined in the Policy and Pavement permission is maintained.
 - d. The layout and orientation of furniture in the area must allow for at least 0.8m to the adjacent kerb line to ensure safety of patrons (this is the area between the seating and kerb line).
