

Application for resource consent – Frank Kitts Park

In accordance with section 95A of the Resource Management Act 1991 Wellington City Council publicly notifies the following resource consent application for the redevelopment of Frank Kitts Park, including the installation of a Chinese Garden.

The application is to redevelop and modify Frank Kitts Park on the Wellington waterfront. The proposed alterations consist of the following principal components:

1. Redevelopment of children's playground
2. Levelling of amphitheatre to create a 'Harbour Lawn'
3. Establishment of a Chinese Garden
4. Creation of an 'Upper Lawn' above the existing parking building.

The above works include associated buildings and structures.

The proposal also includes earthworks in association with the above components.

Your submission must be in the prescribed form, be dated, signed by you and include the following information:

1. Your name, postal address, telephone number, email address and fax number (if applicable).
2. Details of the application you are making the submission on, including location and service request/reference number (see above).
3. Whether you support, oppose or are neutral to the application.
4. Your submission, with reasons.
5. The decision you wish the Council to make.
6. Whether you wish to be heard (make an oral submission) in relation to your submission.

You may make a submission by sending a written or electronic submission. Hard copies of the submission form are available from Wellington City Council, 101 Wakefield Street, Wellington.
