

PLAN TO 'STOP' AND SELL UNFORMED ROAD – GLOVER STREET

Wellington City Council, under Section 342(1) of the Local Government Act 1974, proposes to 'stop' a 611sq m portion of land in Glover Street, Ngauranga.

We no longer require this land for road purposes.

This land, described in the schedule below, is situated next to 13 Glover Street, Ngauranga. Once this area of road land is stopped it would be issued with its own title and marketed for sale. Eight square metres would be retained by Council.

The uses to which the land can be used are governed by the Wellington City Council District Plan.
