

PLAN TO 'STOP' UNFORMED ROAD
EVANS BAY PARADE

Wellington City Council, under Section 342(1) of the Local Government Act 1974, proposes to 'stop' a 70 m² portion of land in Evans Bay Parade, Hataitai, Wellington.

The Council no longer require this land for roading purposes.

The land, described in the schedule below, is situated directly adjoining 214 Evans Bay Parade (Part Lots 1 & 2 DP 21763, and Section 142 Evans Bay District). Once the road land is stopped it would be sold to the owners of 214 Evans Bay Parade, and amalgamated with that property.

The uses to which the land can be used are governed by the Wellington City Council District Plan.
