General rules for freedom camping in Wellington:

- Only certified self-contained vehicles displaying a current warrant card can freedom camp in Wellington.
- You may stay at one of our two freedom camping sites.
 Please only park in a designated freedom camping park (check maps on-site).
- You may stay in an on-street park, just keep within any time limits if any are in place, or other paid parking facilities.
- Freedom camping is not permitted in any WCC Reserves, Coastal Areas, Parks, Sportsfields, and Play Area carparks.
- If your vehicle is not certified self-contained, you need to stay at other places such as a campground.

Park Rangers monitor sites and recreational carparks 7 days a week including public holidays. If you breach the Freedom Camping Bylaw you could receive a **\$400 fine**.


