

## **Released Information – Te Kāinga**

Kōrau Tūāpapa Environment and Infrastructure Committee 8 December 2022.

The Committee:

1. Agreed 2023/24 rent settings for Te Kāinga.
2. Agreed to include six apartments with accessible features, within Te Kāinga's Te Aka building at 203 Willis Street. These will contribute towards the Council's target of 10% accessible apartments in Te Kāinga programme.
3. Agreed to broaden the priority criteria for Te Kāinga, to align with Wellington's Economic Wellbeing Strategy's job creation industries, such as public administration, hospitality, tourism, health care and social assistance, education and training. The Council is also keen to invite artists and workers in start-ups, public transport, and Māori organisations to apply.
