2. - 3. Approve, subject to the terms and conditions noted below, the granting of a new ground lease to Maranui Surf Life Saving Club, or with the approval of the Chief Executive its nominee in accordance with the Local Government Act 2002.

Location: Lyall Bay Parade

Leased Area: Footprint of the Maranui Surf Life Saving Club

building

Term: Ten years and one right of renewal for ten years

Annual rent: \$2,600 per annum plus GST

Sub lease: Limited to the first floor of the building to Maranui

Café Limited.
