The Referendum gives you a chance to have a say on how we elect our Parliaments in the future.

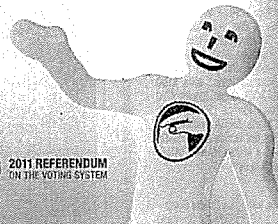

**TE RUNANGA NUI O TE AUPOURI TRUST
SPECIAL RESOLUTION SOUGHT
TO RATIFY DEED OF SETTLEMENT**

The trustees of Te Runanga Nui o Te Aupōuri Trust have now completed negotiations on the Deed of Settlement for the historical Treaty claims of Te Aupōuri.

A Special Resolution of Te Runanga Nui o Te Aupōuri Trust (including a postal ballot) is now needed to ratify the Deed of Settlement, and to allow the trustees of Te Runanga Nui o Te Aupōuri Trust to sign the Deed.

Information booklets and voting papers are currently being sent to all those registered members of Te Aupōuri 18 years of age and over. Full copies of the Deed of Settlement may be viewed at www.teaupouri.iwi.nz, on the Office of Treaty Settlements website: www.ots.govt.nz; and by request at the Te Runanga Nui o Te Aupōuri Trust office, Far North Road, Te Kao, phone: (09) 408 8006 or email: info@teaupouri.iwi.nz. Hard copies are also available for viewing at Te Puni Kōkiri regional offices in Northland and Auckland.

If you are not yet registered, you can still vote. Simply phone the Returning Officer on 0800 922 822 for a special voting pack (including registration form). Alternatively, a special voting pack can be obtained at one of the ratification hui below. Special votes will be counted subject to confirmation of eligibility by the Whakapapa Validation Committee.

Voting will open on 11 November 2011 and close on 12 December 2011. A series of hui will take place during the voting period ending with a Special General Meeting of Te Runanga Nui o Te Aupōuri Trust:
