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## PROPOSED TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – IMPACT REPORT

### *KILBIRNIE FESTIVAL SUNDAY 10 MARCH 2013*

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#### 1. Description of Event

Martin Wilson (Capital Productions Event Management), on behalf of the Kilbirnie Festival Committee, has requested the closure of **Bay Road**, between Rongotai Road and Coutts Street, to vehicle traffic only, for the purpose of the annual Festival on Sunday 10 March 2013, from 6am to 6pm.

The Festival offers craft, display and information stalls, areas of food stalls, children's entertainment, an area for children's rides, and three music stages featuring various Wellington entertainers along with local school and community performance groups.

Road closure notification boards will be placed at each end of the closure at least one week prior to the event. Residents and local businesses will receive a letter drop advising them of the event and the road closure. The event is also to be advertised in the Our Wellington Page of the Dominion Post in the week preceding the festival.

#### 2. Events Directorate Support

The Events Directorate has no connection with, and no objection to, this event.

#### 3. Proposal Notice and Consultation

The public notice that the Council is proposing to consider this closure was published in the following newspaper:

The New Zealand Police and the Ministry of Transport have also been consulted with.

#### 4. Objections

There have been NO objections to this closure request.

## 5. Traffic Impact Assessment

### Prior Closures

None of the proposed closures for this event will result in a road being closed for an aggregate of more than 31 days in any year.

### Traffic Impact

In the opinion of Soon Teck Kong, Manager Transport Network, acting as the Council's Traffic Engineer, the proposed closure, if implemented according to the plans provided, is not likely to impede traffic unreasonably subject to the conditions listed below. However, the Council reserves the right to modify this opinion at any time. If, in the opinion of the Council, the closure may or does impede traffic unreasonably, any approval granted by the Regulatory Processes Committee may be revoked and the event organiser may be required to open the road at the direction of a suitably qualified Council officer in charge of traffic.

Conditions:

- The event organiser is to notify the public via newspaper advertisement, letter drop, advanced signage and media releases.
- The event organiser is to provide a detour route between Rongotai Road and Coutts Street with adequate signage.
- The event organiser is responsible for safety (in particular pedestrian and traffic interactions) within the closed road area.
- Pedestrian movements at the intersections of Bay Road/Coutts Street and Bay Road/Rongotai Road are to be safely managed and controlled by the event organiser as part of the approved Traffic Management Plan.
- The event organiser is to ensure that the emergency services (Police, Fire and Ambulance Services) have been consulted with and that the Traffic Management Plan includes all of their specific requirements.
- The event organiser is responsible for the maintenance of the temporary traffic management plan during the road closure.

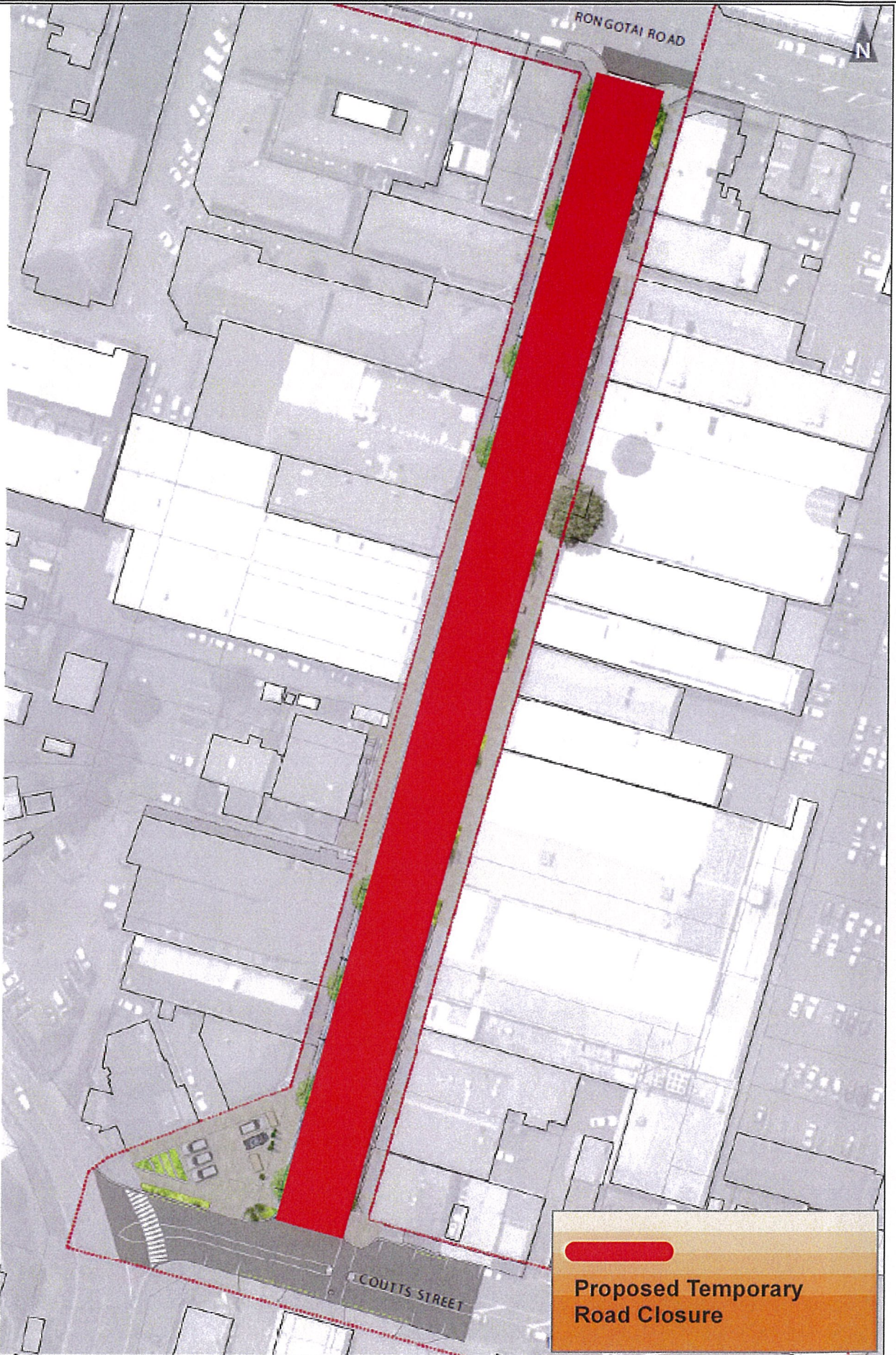

**Approval of Post-Settlement Governance Entity & Investment Framework**  
 Over the last few months Maungaharuru-Tangitū Incorporated (MTI) has held several hui with the Hapū  
 of Tangoio Marae to discuss developing a post-settlement governance entity to receive the assets that  
 will be acquired through the upcoming settlement with the Crown. Also discussed was a proposed  
 Investment Framework to guide investment decisions.  
 The Hapū now have the opportunity to vote on whether the Maungaharuru-Tangitū Trust should be the  
 post-settlement governance entity to receive the assets that will be acquired through the settlement, and  
 to approve the Investment Framework. The resolutions to be voted on are:  
 1. I approve the Trust Deed for the Maungaharuru-Tangitū Trust & that the Trust receive the Treaty  
 Settlement Assets for the Hapū.  
 2. I approve the Investment Framework.  
 MTI will hold several hui to present information about the Maungaharuru-Tangitū Trust and the  
 Investment Framework and to provide an opportunity for questions to be asked. MTI will also provide  
 an update on the progress of the negotiations with the Crown for the settlement of the historical claims  
 of the Hapū. Please note, there will be a separate vote (in 2013) to approve the settlement when the  
 negotiations with the Crown have been completed.
