Our submission

- We do **not** support the proposed amendment to extend the liquor control bylaw to the whole city 24/7
- Any extension should be limited to the problem areas
- It may be reasonable to extend the ban to additional areas such as Wilton to apply during the night only

Proposed bylaw is draconian when compared with the problem

 People drinking irresponsibly in public places (e.g. at bus stops) in Wilton tend to be a nuisance rather than a serious problem. This is caused by just a few individuals.

Picnics

- The bylaw would be a problem for people wanting a drink with a picnic
- The police would probably act reasonably
 - but there would be an element of uncertainty
- The police could be accused of bias if they confiscate one group's beer and leave another group's wine alone

Street parties

- Getting the permit is just one more bit of bureaucracy
- Quickly organised and spontaneous street parties wouldn't be possible

Bad law?

 A law that is applied only occasionally is probably a bad law

Compromise

- Most of the problems seem to occur at night
- Most picnics and street parties occur during the day
- So make the extension apply at night only
