 - a. For the International Rugby Sevens Parade event:
 - i. Stout Street (between Whitmore Street and Bunny Street) for the parade assembly, on Thursday 4 February 2010, from 9am to 1.30pm; and
 - b. For the International Rugby Sevens Street Party event:
 - i. Courtenay Place (all of Courtenay Place, between Cambridge Terrace and Taranaki Street), from 5pm Saturday 6 February to 6am Sunday 7 February 2010; and

- c. For the Wellington Chinese New Year Street Parade event:
 - i. Tennyson Street (between Tory Street and Cambridge Terrace) - for the parade assembly, on Sunday 14 February 2010, from 9am to 2.30pm; and
- d. For the Wellington Round the Bays Fun Run event Sunday 21 February 2010:
 - i. Customhouse Quay (all southbound lanes between Whitmore Street and Jervois Quay), from 7am to 11am

 - v. Green Street (all)
 - vi. Wilson Street (for approximately 80 metres east off Riddiford Street)

 - viii. Normanby Street (for approximately 80 metres east off Riddiford Street) and,
 - ix. Donald McLean Street (for approximately 3 metres east off Riddiford Street),; and
