- 2. Agree to close the following roads for events as shown, to vehicles only, subject to the conditions listed in the Proposed Temporary Road Closure Impact Reports:
 - a. For the "3 Streets in One" event:
 - i. Princess Terrace (between Princess Street and Horner Street), on Saturday 20 March 2010, from 10am to 6pm; and
 - b. For the Meridian Kids Bike Jams event:
 - i. Alexandra Road (between Constable Street and the Lookout Road) on Sunday 2 May 2010, from 9.30am to 1.30pm; and
 - c. For the Harbour Capital Marathon, Half Marathon & 10km Run event:
 - i. Shelly Bay Road (between Miramar Avenue and Massey Road)
 - ii. Massey Road (between Shelly Bay Road to a point just north of Scorching Bay), on Sunday 27 June 2010, from 8am to 11am

- 3. Note that the following roads will remain open but may be managed for vehicle, pedestrian and participant safety by, for example, using seaward side lane closures, marshalled access only and/or parking restrictions:
 - a) Waterloo Quay to Taranaki Street/Taranaki Street Wharf, from 6.30am to 9.45am.
 - b) Herd Street, from 9am to 10.30am.
 - c) Oriental Parade (between Cable Street and Evans Bay Parade), 7am to 11am.
 - d) Evans Bay Parade (between Oriental Parade and Cobham Drive), 7am to 11am.
