## 2. Oral Reports

#### 2.1 Transport Update – Steve Wright, Team Leader

Steve Wright provided an oral update on transport issues including flood damage in the Takarau Gorge. Council have work to do rebuilding culverts, reforming the road, and building 300m of retaining walls.

The cost of works is estimated to be \$1.5 million and will require the road to be closed to the public while work is in progress. Steve explained that they are trying to get a gravel surface in next few weeks but there will need to be closures over the next 12 months while the retaining wall is rebuilt.

There was some discussion around an unconsented culvert at 335 Takarau Gorge Rd, that had caused much of the damage, and what could be done to prevent this type of damage in the future.

There was also discussion about some houses flooding near the beach. It was suggested that a letter be sent to residents to see if they objected to works being done at the river mouth, however there needs to be a discussion with the Regional Council first.

#### 2.2 Board Members' Update

Christine Grace advised that Meridian had planted 3000 trees to date and were conscious of their obligations. She also advised that the Makara Café had new owners and would be open on Thursdays to Sundays.

#### 2.3 Chairperson's Update

Chair John Apanowicz provided an oral report.

- Gorse spraying in Ohariu Valley Rd.
- Correspondence on the unconsented culvert at 335 Takarau Gorge Rd.
- An email from Tim Milstead about the capacity of the telecommunications cabinet and the proposed cost of \$100k to upgrade it for broadband capability. There was some discussion by the board about the future of broadband in poorly serviced areas. John agreed to forward the email to Chris and Christine to see if it would be possible to tap into Meridian's fibre infrastructure.
