
Linden Summary: Population, Demographics, and Services




Linden vs Wellington City















Linden vs Wellington City











Prominent Group Visualisations (Median vs Mode)

Visualising sub-suburb areas by **most prominent** rather than by median.


Renting vs Owner-Occupier




Personal Income




Renting vs Owner-Occupier




Rental Type

Years in Residence







