-	group	Welcome from Chairperson. Chairperson asked that the first items on the Agenda be moved to the end of the meeting and allow time for Afamasaga Tealu Moresi from Samoa Capital Radio to proceed with his presentation. The group agreed.

1	SamoaCapital Radio	<u>Discussions: Samoa Capital Radio</u>

		Samoa Capital Radio – Afamasaga Tealu Moresi: A hardcopy proposal was tabled by Afamasaga.
		Please see Pacific Advisor if you would like to obtain a copy.
		Afamasaga is the CEO for Samoa Capital Radio. Afamasaga presented a hard copy proposal about how SCR can promote the Pasifika Festival and how this can work with other Language radio stations.
		Afamasaga spoke to his proposal. Promotions can be done through clients that are with SCR and put up Posters in clients shops and stores.
		Through a project that SCR and Access Radio Language Programmes are working with CCDHB Afamasaga has spoken with project leader about promoting the Festival during this timeslot. Project leader very happy to work colabratively to promote the Festival during their programme slot.
		There could be an opportunity for each Nation to be on stage on the day of the Festival to promote and talk about your community in your own language.
		A stall oppourtunity has been offered to Access Radio. SCR will take the lead for everyone and use this opportunity.
		Danny Kauraka from Ivanui Cook Island Radio station has sent through a proposal to Afamasaga with monetary figures.
		Ida has asked the rest of the group to send their proposals through to Afamasaga before the Festival.
		Afamasaga has suggested that it would be good for all Language Programme presenters to talk with SCR to sort out their programmes.
		Afamasaga will link in with the Councillors for PAG to sort out interview times.
2	Pasifika Festival 2011	<u>Pasifika Festival Update:</u> Rebecca handed out Posters and will send out the email format for people to distribute. Festival has been promoted through the Capital Times and the Council Website.
		Start time on the Posters is 9.30am. Marie brought up a point that the reason why the Festival started a bit

later was because there were never enough people on site during the Opening Formalities.
Andy expessed that this is the only time the Mayor was available and the Mayor had expressed that she is very keen to attend.
Ida asked the group to please ask their communities to be at the park early for the formalities.
Danny asked that if all stalls can open by 9.30am this could help bring the communities in on the day for the formalities.
PA(Pacific Advisor) explained that this would all depend on the Health Inspections for the Food Stalls after the Inspector had gone through them.
<u>Food Stalls & Craft Stalls:</u> Rebecca reported back to the group that the Food Stall Holders briefing will be held on Thursday 17 February 5.30pm in Committee Room 1. All Food Stall Holders are to attend this meeting.
PA asked if their would be a meeting with the Health Inspector before the Food Stall Holders meeting to look at menus? Rebecca replied that this can be organised and will liaise with PA to attend to help with the knowledge around Pacific Foods. Rebecca to organise meeting with Health Inspector and notify PA.
An update on all Stalls will be sent out by Rebecca.
There are no Samoan craft stalls. An idea was put forward to approach Langi's Island Styles to be the craft stall for the Samoan community. Rebecca will make contact and report back to the group.
<u>Theming for the Festival:</u> Rebecca explained that Shane Tufferey has been approached to work on Pacific Panels for the theming of the Festival. This programme will link with the children on the day.
Shane is looking after the artists that will be working on the panels. Andrew Richardson will be decorating the stage with make-shift palm trees.
<u>VIP's Update:</u>

VIP invites have been sent out this week ($07/02 - 11/02$). The RSVP for the VIP's invitation is this week on Friday 11.
Questions were asked about who was going on stage out of the VIP's? Ana to coordinate the VIPs on the day and take up those who will be speaking as there may not be enough room on the stage for all the VIP's.
Rebecca to send the list of VIP's that have been invited.
<u>Headline Act:</u> Headline Act has not been confirmed yet. There are a few people that have been contacted. King Kapisi made contact but the costings are very high and he would be flying in from Auckland.
People that have been contacted are: Rosita Vai Musical Island Boys (MIB) King Kapisi
Danny asked if it was possible to have Cindy of Samoa perform again as she was a great hit with the Pacific communities last year.
Marie phoned Cindy and confirmed that Cindy of Samoa is available for the 26 February and her fee would be \$2000.00
Group agreed that Cindy of Samoa would be one the main act. Rebecca expressed that the budget for the Headline Act was \$5K and the Festival would be able to afford Rosita Vai and MIB. Group agreed for all 3 groups to be asked to perform if the budget allows it to. Rebecca will contact Rosita and MIB to confirm.
Rebecca will have a performance programme by Friday to send out to PAG.
Payment for Groups: If a group is registered under a church name they will be paid on the day. Please email Rebecca if you have any concerns about getting your group paid on the day.

Site Visit:
