### Youth and Emergency Management: Towards a Youth Council approach

Simon asked YC members to think about the Youth Council's approach to the Youth and Emergency Management project, and what advice it could provide to Jason Paul at WREMO. WREMO is keen for people to change their behaviour. Simon circulated an information sheet on behaviour change and spoke about successful behaviour change initiatives. YC members did some small group work to identify 'ideal type' characters who might be the subjects of the YC's advice.

Ben suggested that this could be a good questionnaire for young people that we would like to reach. Zared pointed out that we should also consider people who think that nothing will happen to them or nothing should be done as we are all likely to die anyway. Morgan suggested that we should go for a geographical approach and indentify areas like Kilbirnie airport which are most likely to get affected during an earthquake. Simon said he will get more information on natural hazard risks versus planned growth in Wellington.
