Minutes

1. Opening

Zoe welcomed the group.

2. Apologies

Apologies were received from Ben Oglivie, James Wall-Manning, Lily Simmons-Donaldson, Morgan Watkins and Zared Wall-Manning.

3. What's on top

Members reported a diverse range of 'what's on top' activities including driving lesson, buying a house, studying, exams, job hunting, working and spending two weeks in Auckland filming and dancing.

5. Previous minutes and matters arising

Jack moved that the minutes be accepted as true and correct for 3 October meeting. Brydon seconded the motion. Devon moved that the minutes be accepted as true and correct for 17 October meeting. Jack seconded the motion.

7. General Business

5th United Nations Alliance of Civilizations Forum (Devon)

The Forum will be held in February 2013 at the UN headquarters in Vienna. The UN will cover the costs for successful applicants.

Zoe moved that Devon could apply to attend the Forum as the YC's representative and that Devon should present on Forum to Youth Council in 2013. The motion was passed unanimously.

Working group for a submission on the draft Town Belt Management Plan and proposals for legislation

The working group to develop a YC submission on the draft Town Belt Management Plan and proposals for legislation was formed. It comprises Bing, Jack, Brydon and Zoe.

Bill Rosenberg, Economist and Director of Policy for the Council of Trade Unions

Simon welcomed Bill Rosenberg from the Council of Trade Unions, who gave a presentation on the following themes:

- Overview of employment, unemployment among young people
- Regional employment participation and Regional unemployment
- Economic Growth and NZ situation
- Global recession (international situation)
- What measures to take over short term and long term to address this situation?

YC members had a number of questions including:

- 1. What do you think of the Government's plans?
- 2. What does future look like? Can we return to full employment?
- 3. Apart from primary industry exports, what can New Zealand export?
- 4. What can cities like Wellington do to make economy better?

Regarding question 4, Bill suggested that WCC could promote programmes such as the Mayor's Taskforce for Jobs. This could include schemes to match students to job opportunities. Local Authorities could also use their purchasing power to support local businesses and help young people into employment by providing internships.

Zoe thanked Bill for his insightful presentation. YC members gave Bill a round of applause.
