The whole event was really emotional and it was amazing how people opened up in front of strangers.

Success factors included:

- Sharing food first help set up the right atmosphere for sharing stories
- The 3 organisations involved brought people along from their diverse communities
- There was excellent leadership and delegation of responsibility
- The event structure was simple
- YC led the event itself

Outcomes included:

- Queen Charlotte College is going to schedule it yearly trip to Wellington for Youth Week so that its students can attend similar events
- The Minister of Youth Affairs heard about the event the next day
- The YC should be confident about future events as it pulled off something great in a very short time

The YC should look at collaborating with Evolve and Youthline again next Youth Week and make the event bigger. The next event needs to ensure that support is available after the event.
