- 3. Note that the 2020/21 Statement of Intent for the Wellington Regional Development Agency Ltd (trading as WellingtonNZ) was accepted by the Wellington Regional Strategy Committee at its meeting held on 9th June 2020.
- 4. Agree to recommend to the Strategy and Policy Committee that it accepts the 2020/21 Statements of Intent for the Basin Reserve Trust, the Karori Sanctuary Trust, the Wellington Cable Car Limited, the Wellington Museums Trust, the Wellington Regional Stadium Trust and the Wellington Zoo Trust.
- 5. Note that the CCO committee will make allowance for the challenges arising from COVID-19 as we monitor CCO performance against these SOIs throughout the year, given the likelihood that this pandemic will continue to affect CCO operations and the uncertainty pertaining to these effects.
- 6. Note that to support the successful ongoing operations of our CCOs during these challenging times Wellington City Council has made provision for essential funding support related to COVID-19 of up to \$5.0 million for its council-controlled organisations in its 2020/21 annual plan and that there is a process in place for CCOs to access this funding if required.
