

How to use the WCC District Plan Independent Hearing Panel (IHP) Recommendations Viewer

Overview

This application is prepared for the Councillors to compare changes between the notified Proposed District Plan map layers and the Independent Hearing Panel-recommended map layers for Hearing Streams 1-5. The viewer shows specific:

- Proposed District Plan layers at notification,
- Layers after incorporating changes recommended by the Independent Hearing Panel in its Hearing reports

For ease of comparison, the notified Proposed District Plan map layers and the Independent Hearing Panel-recommended map layers are shown side by side in two separate panes.

Notes:

This is a live viewer. Layers for the hearing streams will be uploaded in stages as per the briefing timeline. The layers will be grouped by stream number and District Plan Chapters.

Introduction to the Viewer

- The viewer shows two side-by-side panes to compare changes between the notified Proposed District Plan map layers and the Independent Hearing Panel-recommended map layers
- The panes are linked (pan and zoom together) for ease of comparing
- Each pane has its own list of layers and legends showing on the right-hand side of the viewer.

IHP Recommended Pane: shows map layers after incorporating changes recommended by the Independent Hearing Panel in its Hearing reports



Layers and legend window: Shows layers and legend for respective panes grouped by Hearing Stream and District Plan chapter

Layers and Legends

- Layers and legends for the two map viewing panes are shown in two separate windows on the right-hand side of the viewer.
- The top window shows layers and legends for WCC Notified District Plan layers and bottom one shows the same for IHP-recommended layers. Layers in each window can be controlled independently.
- Layers are grouped by Hearing Streams and District Plan chapters and are nested within respective Hearing Streams. Click on the dropdown arrow icon () next to the checkbox to view nested layers.
- Users can toggle each layer on or off to control a group/ layer's visibility.
- Legend are included under each group and layer.
- To see the legend at group level, click on the expand icon () next to the group.
- To view the legends at layer level, click on the expand icon () next to the specific layer.
- To view details or export IHP recommended layers, click on the three dots () next to the layers. Files can be exported in JSON, GeoJSON and CSV format.

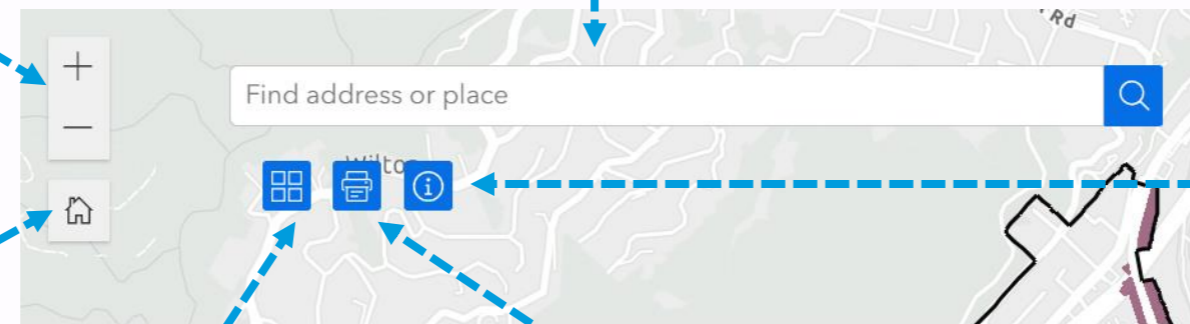
Other Tools and Widgets

There are designated set of tools, widgets and search bar for each pane to customise layer view under Notified Proposed District Plan pane and IHP Recommended pane easily

Zoom in or out of the map in the viewer. The zoom level of panels are linked. So, if you zoom in or out in one pane, it will be reflected in the other pane too

The search bar allows you to quickly find a specific address or location within the map

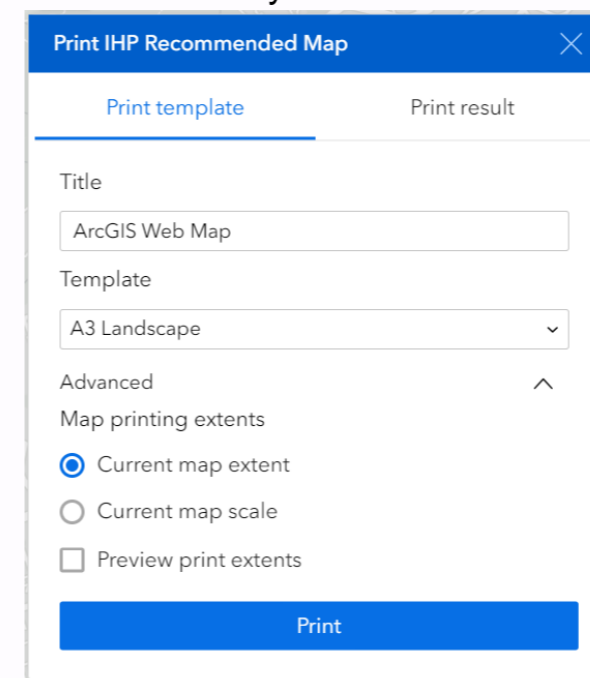
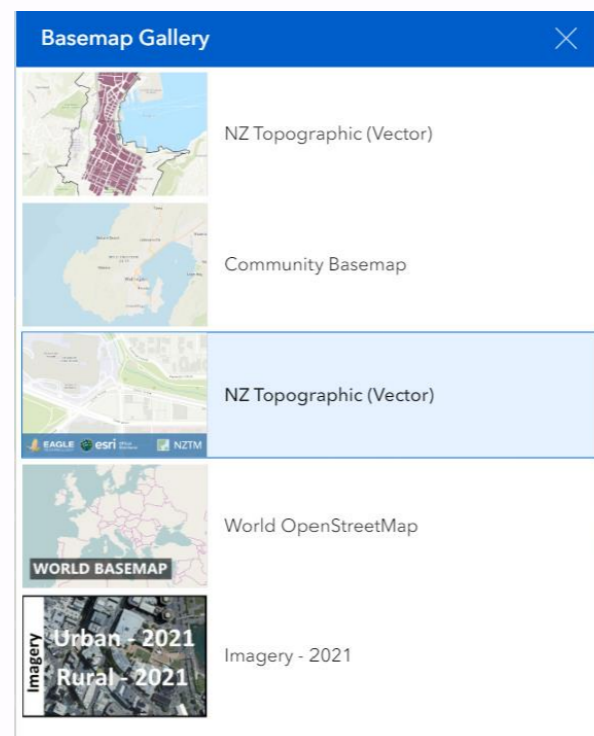
Default map view resets the pane view to the default setting



By clicking on the "How to Use" icon you can navigate to the "How to Use" document anytime.

The Base Map Gallery includes a selection of satellite imagery, street maps, and topographic maps to choose from, allowing you to customize the look of the maps

Print function lets you create a PDF map of the current view within the viewer. You can specify the map title, size, and format to suit your needs.



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
