- The Hearing Panel will have read all submissions, evidence, and pre-circulated documents. Your presentation should focus on the key points of your submission.
- Please ensure you are present at the hearings venue or have joined the Microsoft Teams meeting **at least 30 minutes** before you are due to speak.
- If you require a translator (NZ sign or te reo Māori) please notify the Hearing Co-ordinator **at least 10 working days prior to the hearing**.
- If you have an electronic presentation over 3 A4 pages, please email this to Jaskirat.kaur@wcc.govt.nz by **1pm Friday 5 May**. Please email any presentations less than 3 A4 pages at least 1 working day before the hearing commences.
