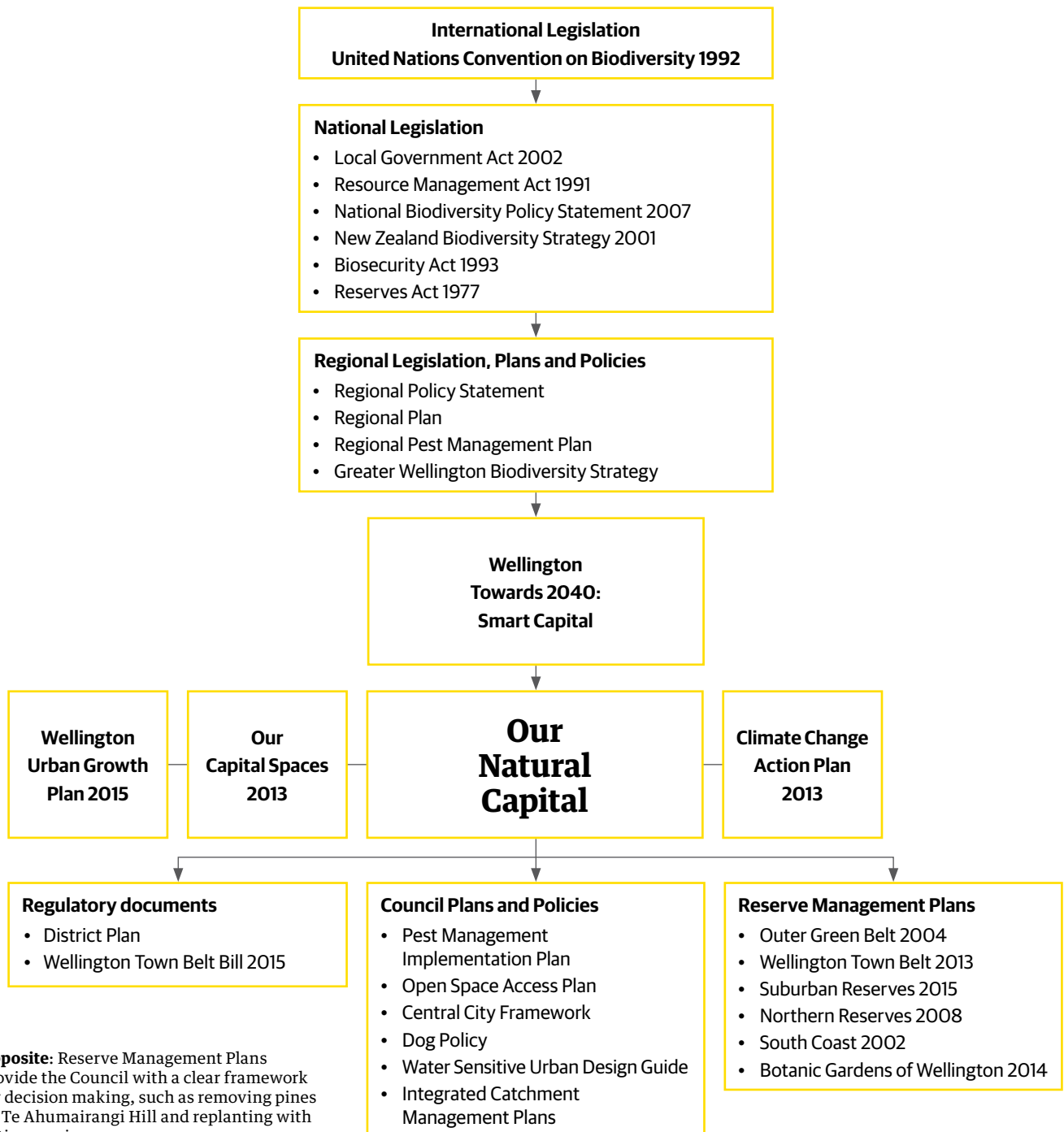


6. Policy framework

Our Natural Capital underpins everything that we do as a City.

The city is part of a greater whole and needs to be seen in the context of the agencies that have responsibilities for the Wellington region and the country as a whole. This includes national and regional policy influencing biodiversity as well as Wellington City Council’s strategy, policy and planning documents.
