Construction is now in full swing in Egmont Street with different parts of the Street getting upgraded. ➔ The works

The next step is to complete the asphalt area. Due to the large potholes, there will be part closure of Egmont Street for approximately 4-5 hours this Saturday 11 June, this is dependent on the weather. Access from Dixon and Ghuznee Streets will be open, however drive through access will not be available from one end to the other. Pedestrians will still have full access to Egmont Street.

We are also painting the walls of Egmont Street, starting with water blasting. Due to the height of Bond Store building, there will be a scissor lift in place and barriers around for vehicle and pedestrian access.

➔ Safety and access

Our work hours will be from 7.30am - 5pm, during this time there will be some disruption and changes to access. The lane will remain open and we will have traffic management in place to allow both pedestrian and vehicle movements. We apologise for any inconvenience that this may cause.
