➔ The works

The first part of the works will be the civil elements. This includes the replacement of the asphalt, the removal of old bollards and pieces of old concrete that have become trip hazards, the building of concrete footings and replacement of drainage covers and the like. These works will commence on Tuesday 24 May, depending on the weather.

We will also be commencing the painting later in the week, and will be conducting some testing of the uprights on the Bond Store on Thursday 26.

➔ Safety and access

Our work hours will be from 7.30am - 5pm, during this time there will be some disruption and changes to access. The lane will remain open and we will have traffic management in place to allow both pedestrian and vehicle movements. We apologise for any inconvenience that this may cause.
