We have largely completed the resurfacing and painting works and are now moving into the second stage of construction. The honey comb planter extension and street light installation are about to start. Some jobs are weather dependent which means if it is really cold or wet, we may have to alter what we do and when.

➔ The works

We are waiting for a good sunny day to complete the last section of resurfacing in Egmont Street. This is the Ghuznee Street end of Egmont Street. This work will close the access entry from Ghuznee Street, but all access through Egmont Street, including iDEAL carpark will be accessible from Dixon Street entrance. Pedestrians will still have full access to Egmont Street, however drive through access will not be available from one end to the other. The Honey comb planter extension has started and the working area has been coned off for safety. From next week, street light installation will start and may require a scissor lift for works on height. Barriers will be put up for vehicle and pedestrian access.

➔ Safety and access

Our work hours will be from 7.30am - 5pm, during this time there will be some disruption and changes to access. The lane will remain open and we will have traffic management in place to allow both pedestrian and vehicle movements. We apologise for any inconvenience that this may cause.
