



Eva and Leeds streets – a celebration of Wellington

Construction is now in full swing in Leeds Street and the reasonable run of weather has meant we have been able to keep to the programme with just some minor adjustments. Some jobs are temperature dependent which means if it is really cold, we sometimes have to alter what we do when.

→ The works

The next step is to complete the footpath. We are preparing the concrete slabs, getting the levels adjusted for the asphalt area and constructing the planter edge around the trees.

We are also getting ready to install *Shoelaces* light installation which will be part of the Lux Festival. This will be located on the handrail of the Hannah's Factory building and visible from Hannah's Courtyard for the duration of the light festival, which begins on 21 August.

→ Safety and access

We have had to make a few changes to improve safety, including moving barriers to the perimeter of our work site.

This is safer for the public, work crews and surrounding properties, but it does mean you'll need to use the Hannah's Courtyard to gain access to your businesses and homes most of the time during normal work hours. We apologise for any inconvenience that this change may have caused.
